

The Ghana Science & Tech Explorer Prize (GSTEP)

Mentor Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to mentor applicants of the Ghana Science and Tech Explorer Prize (GSTEP):

- 1. Mentors must be knowledgeable of STEM and its practical application. Knowledge can be demonstrated by professional experience, subject matter expertise, or involvement in STEM-related initiatives.
- 2. Mentors must be based in Greater Accra, Ashanti or Eastern Regions between June 2023 and October 2023.
- Mentors must be able to commit an hour a week between June 2023 and October 2023 to work with their mentee group, in-person engagement is preferred.
- 4. Mentors should have the flexibility to take in-person and virtual sessions.
- 5. Mentors should be 18 years or older.
- 6. Mentors should be able to provide appropriate guidance to group members in the development of their solution for the Challenge.
- 7. Mentors must be able to coordinate with teacher representatives assigned to their mentee group for cohesion within the group and oversight over the group's performance in the Challenge.
- 8. Mentors should be able to encourage discussion and constructive work within the group without judgment.
- 9. Mentors should have availability to attend three key in-person events in the GSTEP programme.
- 10. Mentors must maintain professional etiquette in the discharge of their duties.
- 11. Mentors must acknowledge that this is a voluntary programme with no payment for the work done.
